Cemeteries Responding to bushfire risk

Safer places

Council has a process for limiting use of some community facilities during elevated fire danger weather. The aim is to minimise the number of people in high risk areas during times of heightened fire danger.

A risk rating has been used to classify facilities based on a number of characteristics including the number of people likely to be using a facility and how easy is it to get away from bush fire prone land in the event of an unexpected fire.

Some Council managed cemeteries are on bushfire prone land and measures to reduce risk are put in place at certain times during dangerous conditions. This new process focuses on large groups of people, but it is still good practice for individuals to avoid these higher risk places during high fire danger periods.

Berrima, Bundanoon, Penrose, Robertson and Welby cemeteries

Changes to the way people visit cemeteries would occur when fire danger ratings reach *high, extreme* or *catastrophic*. **See the table over the page for information on each cemetery.**

Under the highest fire danger rating of *catastrophic*, burials at Berrima, Bundanoon, Penrose, Robertson and Welby cemeteries would be held over to another day.

At *extreme* ratings measures to reduce the number of people attending high risk areas are used. Mitigation measures include limiting graveside services and the number of people able to attend burials.

How will I know if a cemetery is restricted?

Council works with funeral directors to respond to changing fire danger ratings.

In addition, each cemetery has a web page which will have the information about when a facility will be closed. The website also provides a link to the fire danger rating. Fire danger ratings are updated by the Rural Fire Services generally by 4pm each afternoon.
