At its meeting on 16 November 2022 Council considered a report to waive and refund fees and charges for the Bowral Classic cycling event which was held in the Southern Highlands on the weekend of the 15 and 16 October 2022 to the sum of \$6348.82.

Data will be available early December on the economic benefits of the event for the community, however based on the average length of stay, it is anticipated that riders will have spent over \$800,000 in the Shire over the Bowral Classic weekend.

Progress on the *Casburn Park Upgrade Project* continues to gather momentum with Council awarding the contract to develop the Detailed Design to landscape architect specialist *Complete Urban*.

Work on the Detailed Design follows the adoption by Council of the *Casburn Park Masterplan* in May 2021.

The Detailed Design of Casburn Park is expected to be complete early next year with initial construction anticipated to start in mid-2023.
