NOTICE OF PUBLIC RE-EXHIBITION - DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO WINGECARRIBEE LOCAL STRATEGIC PLANNING STATEMENT AND LOCAL HOUSING STRATEGY

On 24 June 2020, Council adopted the Wingecarribee Local Strategic Planning Statement (LSPS) and Local Housing Strategy after an eight (8) week public exhibition period.

The draft LSPS and Local Housing Strategy provide a 20-year land use vision for the Wingecarribee Shire, and a planning framework to meet the economic, housing, social and environmental needs of the community.

At the Ordinary Council meeting of 9 December 2020, it was resolved to 'undertake consultation with the community of Robertson in regard to the Local Housing Strategy and Local Strategic Planning Statement in February 2021 to remove the identified North Eastern Land Release in Robertson'.

In accordance with the above resolution, the revised Wingecarribee Local Housing Strategy and Local Strategic Planning Statement will be publicly exhibited for a period of six (6) weeks from Monday 8 February to Friday 19 March 2021 (inclusive).

PUBLIC EXHIBITION: The draft amended LSPS and Local Housing Strategy will be formally exhibited online via <https://www.yoursaywingecarribee.com.au>, and hard copy material will be made available for viewing at Council's Civic Centre during business hours. The LSPS and Local Housing Strategy will be exhibited from Monday 8 February to Monday 22 March 2021 (inclusive). The purpose of the amendments is to include the newly established Aitken Road Conservation Area within the existing Conservation Precinct controls in the DCP and to make an addition and some minor amendments to the existing controls.
