8.12 Black Summer Bushfire Recovery Fund Successful Grant

PURPOSE

This report advises Council of the outcome of the recent applications to the Black Summer Bushfire Recover Fund and specifically Council related projects.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT

1. Council note the successful applications to the Federal Government Black Summer Bushfire Recovery Fund totalling \$1,049,000:
 - a. \$510,000 for the provision of Water Storage Tanks at Canyonleigh, Bullio, High Range/Joadja, Penrose
 - b. \$389,000 for a Community Resilience Officer and Program for 2 years full time to work with the Northern and Southern Villages in Prevention, Preparedness, Response and Resilience in Community Recovery.
 - c. \$150,000 for the provision of a Fenced Off Leash Dog Park, at Jordons Crossing Bundanoon
2. Council note other projects to receive funding locally:
 - a. \$391,632 - Paint the Town (across both Wollondilly & Wingecarribee)
 - b. \$272,618 – PCYC Social Recovery & Resilience programs
 - c. \$215,779 – Balmoral Village Community Hub
 - d. \$196,844 - Hill Top Village Park Project
3. Council write to the Federal Member, the Hon. Angus Taylor to thank him for his support in these applications, bringing a total of \$2,125,873 to the Wingecarribee Shire to support the recovery from the Black Summer Fires.

REPORT

BACKGROUND

Council at its meeting held on 8 September considered a report on projects to be submitted under the Federal; Government Black Summer Bushfire Recovery Funds.

Council subsequently resolved:

THAT the following grant applications be prepared and submitted by Council to BSBR:



1. *Jordan's Crossing Bundanoon, off-leash dog park*
2. *Water storage tanks at RFS stations at Canyonleigh, Bullio, High Range/Joadja, Penrose project*
3. *Walking trails of the Wingecarribee Shire, signage improvements project*
4. *Resilience Officer*

AND THAT Council support Hill Top Community Association application to BSBR.

REPORT

Council has received advice this week that the following Council submitted grant applications have been successful, totalling \$1,049,000:

- \$510,000 – Water Storage Tanks at Canyonleigh, Bullio, High Range/Joadja, Penrose
- \$389,000 – Community Resilience Officer Program to fund a 2 years full time project officer at Council to work with the Northern and Southern Villages in Prevention, Preparedness, Response and Resilience in Community Recovery. This position would also support implementing the recommendations of the Bushfire Response and Recovery Review.
- \$150,000 - Jordan's Crossing Fenced Off Leash Dog Park, Bundanoon
- In addition to the Council submitted applications the following Wingecarribee Shire based applications were also successful.
- \$391,632 - Paint the Town (across both Wollondilly & Wingecarribee)
- \$272,618 – PCYC Social Recovery & Resilience programs
- \$215,779 – Balmoral Village Community Hub
- \$196,844 - Hill Top Village Park Project

With a total of \$2,125,873 has been received to support the Wingecarribee Shire Community in the recovery from the Black Summer Fires.
