Bowral Waste Facility What is the life expectancy of the tip?	The lifespan of the Bowral Waste Facility is dependent on when the tip area is full and can be capped. This is a gradual process and the consent for that use does not include a specific end date. Over time various requirements have changed under the applicable legislation and this continues to be the case.
Bowral CBD masterplan Where is it up to?	A consultant brief is being prepared and will be reported to Council early 2022.
Station Street Item to Council about a block of land behind Eastbrook Medical Centre regarding sale of the land. When it is coming to Council to be sold? Plastic recycling plant in Moss Vale A state significant development. What is the position of council on this proposal?	This was reported back to Council Meeting on 8 December. Council resolved that a Traffic and Transport Study be commissioned to assess future road requirements and options for traffic management within the Bowral CBD. A briefing for residents will be conducted in early 2022.
Mittagong Pool What is happening with Mittagong Pool?	Council is engaging a consultant to undertake a Community and Recreational Facilities Strategy for the Shire as one integrated document instead of developing separate strategy documents (Sports Facility Strategy and Aquatic Facilities Strategy). The intent of this strategic approach is to ensure best use of community funds in the delivery of local, district and regional facilities and services. The Community and Recreational Facilities Strategy will guide the delivery of a sustainable and equitable network of facilities located in strategic and accessible positions across the LGA. The strategy will investigate options for a regional aquatic leisure facility and service provision for both present and future needs. This will guide the future of Mittagong pool.
