Issues raised	Response
Vegetation on Hill top 80km zone down into Balmoral has gone crazy after the fires so close to the edge of the road almost hit the dead trees that have fallen close to the road edge. Worried that this could cause an accident. Needs to be removed.	Vegetation is included in the EPA green waste clean-up grant.
From East Parade/Orange Rd, to Balmoral Park Rd, bushes are closing in, massive hazard. Never seen the vegetation been cleared. Trees fell over on the nature strip and resident had to clean up himself, still not picked up and has since grown over on opposite side of the road to his property. East Parade is forgotten about.	Vegetation is included in the EPA green waste clean-up grant. When trees fall over it is recommended that customers contact Council to notify of the failed tree. This way Council officers are able to explain why we do leave some trees (where safe to do so) in the roadside corridor.
Wilson Drive section not far from Godfreys property – on side of the road there is a shear drop off. No guardrail and Council have been notified. There was a car accident and they were saved by a tree that was in the culvert. Huge safety issue on currently on public forums. Can Council address?	This is a capital works project, that requires further investigation and design.
Trees currently falling on property at 61 Balmoral Park Rd, huge trees nearly fell on house. A great deal of dead trees around. IA advised that Community Recovery Officer will contact this couple.	Staff contacted the customer on the 17/01/22
