EVA is very pleased to see that Council's extensive Heritage Study is to be discussed at Council's Meeting on Wednesday.

There is concern though that, at the same meetin there is a recommendation that concrete should be the preferred material for the construction of all pathways throughout the Shire.

In order to maintain the rural character of Exeter Village, EVA has always advocated for the use of crushed granite. The use of concrete for pathways and driveways risks giving the village a more suburban appearance and feel. and is less sympathetic to its heritage.

We would appreciate it if you could take this into account when this matter comes before you. and ensure that Exeter is exempted from this blanket recommendation.
