Garden History



Our community garden was established by volunteers in 2018 to provide a welcome resting place for travellers and local residents to gather. Our three key objectives in partnering with Trains NSW to use their site were to:

- Protect & nurture the natural environment
- Encourage local healthy food production
- Build community skills and connectedness

Garden practices

We use sustainable practices, and creatively recycle objects to provide re-purposed uses in the garden. We seek to improve the soil and use chemical free growing methods. We have become more environmentally aware of the need to be good custodians of the land and try to support the environment for native birds, animals and beneficial pollinators. Our garden has three veggie wicking beds, a herb bed, two pollinator beds and a mix of native and cottage garden plants.

Everyone is welcome to pop in on Mondays between 10 -12 or come to the monthly plant buy swap mini market from 10 – 12.30 on the 4th Saturday of the month.

Learning by doing

Our garden volunteers have a job description that explains their role and health and safety requirements and we have insurance for our volunteers. We are a friendly group and welcome new members.

To help our resident volunteer gardeners improve their knowledge skills and abilities, Yerrinbool Village Community Railway Garden has partnered with Community Greening from the Mt Annan Botanical Gardens to offer quarterly workshops on gardening-related topics.
