Whites Creek Moss Vale



The catchment and floodplains of Whites Creek fall within the broader Moss Vale subregion of the Hawkesbury/ Nepean Catchment Management Area (CMA). Whites Creek is 7.2 km long, it flows through Moss Vale in a north-west direction and the catchment has a number of land uses within the area. In the upper reaches there is parkland and rural areas, followed by the urbanised

town before returning to rural land at the bottom of the catchment.

The rural/open space mainly consists of farming land in the downstream and upstream reaches of the catchment and the Moss Vale Golf Course in the upper section of the catchment. The urban area is made up of; residential, business, special uses and is mainly located within the middle of the catchment area.
