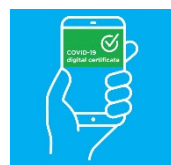
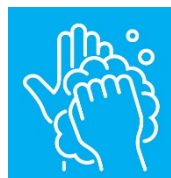


# Southern Regional Livestock Exchange Entry Requirements



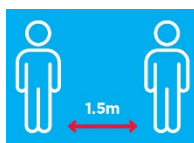
Proof of vaccination

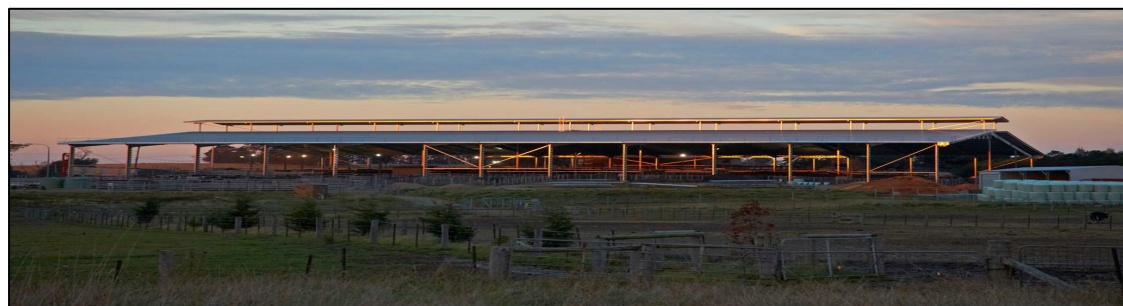

On Monday 8 November 2021 the NSW Government further eased the COVID restrictions for fully vaccinated people. Does this apply to the Southern Regional Livestock Exchange? Yes! However.....

- Visitors must provide evidence of being fully vaccinated or have a medical exemption at the point of entry.

## What's changed?

- Indoor capacity limits have been increased to 1 person / 2 m<sup>2</sup> meaning the indoor capacity at the Saleyards is now set at 94 individuals.

The following restrictions will remain in place until further changes to public health orders.

- Only pre-approved Council staff, livestock selling agents, their staff, contractors and carriers can access the facility at any time.
- Pre-approved, registered, genuine buyers are permitted on site on sale day only.
- Physical distancing, QR Codes, washing hands regularly and remaining at home if you are unwell all remain a requirement.
- Face masks are ONLY a requirement INDOORS

## How long will these restrictions be in place?

Restrictions on unvaccinated visitors will remain in line with NSW Health advice.
