1 Engagement

- Regional Manager's ensure businesses are aware of programs & assist them to access them
- Provide a source of intelligence & advice to the Minister & the Department.
- Advise re new programs. It is recommended to subscribe to receive alerts for new funding programs. https://business.gov.au/ eg Manufacturers getting energy costs down. Bespoke training for manufacturers. Original equipment Manufacture (OEM) training

2 Research & Development Tax Incentive Programme

The Australian Government's key mechanism to stimulate research and development investment in Australia. It offers a tax offset for companies conducting eligible research and development activities. AusIndustry and the Australian Tax Office jointly administer the tax incentive.

- An entitlement scheme (rather than grant), claimed back through tax system
- For companies spending more than \$20K spent in eligible research
- Self assessed and not easy so advisor assistance is a good idea

- Must be a company that has traded for at least 3 years
- Turnover >\$1.5M or less than \$10M
- Operating in one of govt five identified growth sectors. (*major ones)
 - Advanced manufacturing *
 - Food and agribusiness*
 - Medical technologies and pharmaceuticals
 - Mining equipment, technology and services
 - Oil, gas and energy resources
- Business Australia delivers this program in NSW and ACT
- You'll be paired with an independent facilitator. Your facilitator will assess your business
 then recommend operational and growth opportunities, and give advice on applying for the
 Growth Grant. Wholistic view of the business structure, systems, markets. Addresses pain
 points business is feeling at the time. Quick Wins. Identify some longer term aims that could
 assist in growth of the business.
- You can apply at any time
- There are three Growth Services
 - Growth Roadmap
 - o High Growth Accelerator
 - SMART Projects and Supply Chains
- Each program has 2 key stages
 - Facilitation stage connects you with a facilitator
 - Grant stage to fund growth opportunities
- \$20K dollar for dollar must be related to an item that's come up in working on the business. 12-15 hours engagement advisor/business. Eligibility every five years.
 Good program, good response from businesses. Benefit fresh set of eyes. Can access the program with the advisor. Don't have to pay money. Eg dollar for dollar, lean manufacturing principles. Family business.....

- Assists businesses to engage with university research sector

Up to \$130K matched funding. Three components

- \$30K employing a recent graduate (masters or higher) popular with SMEs
- \$50K university researcher working in the university on a technical challenge
- \$50K university researcher working the business

Need good understanding of what university's particular research strengths. Where are researchers good with working with business

3.4 Accelerating Commercialisation

No local advisor as someone is appointed based on ensuring a right fit with the business and is highly connected with that industry. Eg specialty in ICT, engineering, telecoms, life sciences, pharmaceuticals. Peter Masterson is the first point of contact.

- Open to anyone. Individual, sole trader, company
- If successful in getting a grant, govt will ask you to form a company
- Help to commercialise new intellectual property innovative, unique
- Dollar for dollar grants up to \$1M.
- Heavy advisory component from a commercialisation facilitator from start up industries / experienced.
- Quite general, large amounts of money, lots of interest hard nut to crack, difficult to get funding out of.
- Grants of \$300-\$400K prove to be the sweet spot for matching
