Accessible Toilets and MLAK

The Master Locksmith Access Key (MLAK) is an innovative system that enables people with disability to gain 24/7 access to a network of public facilities.

Eligible people with disability can purchase an MLAK key which opens all accessible toilets displaying the MLAK symbol.

A limited number of keys are available for eligible residents to purchase from Council for \$25.00.

Application forms and keys are available at Council's Civic Centre or at the Visitor Information Centre in Mittagong.
Alternatively, application forms can be downloaded from Council's website and can be submitted via email to

mail@wsc.nsw.gov.au.

Applications are restricted to people with disability living in the Wingecarribee Shire, with a limit of one key per applicant. The key is not transferable and is only to be used by the person to whom it has been issued.

Council's Bushcare Program encourages the community to get out into nature and restore ecological sites within Council managed Bushland Reserves.

Groups work to restore and rehabilitate bushland, waterways and wetlands and make a real and practical difference to the environment.

The Citizen Science Program is about encouraging the public to get involved in biodiversity monitoring and research. Council delivers workshops and events for the community to learn and be involved in citizen science. This includes reporting koala sightings to Council's Koala Hotline and the use of citizen science applications (e.g. iNaturalist) that enable community members to photograph and record their plant and animal sightings.

Lifetime pet registration

As required under the Companion Animals Act 1998 your dog or cat should be lifetime registered by six months old. If you have an older pet who is unregistered, registration should be completed immediately. The fee for lifetime registration is a one-off fee which is reduced if your pet is desexed. The National Desexing Network (NDN) has veterinarians available who offer discount desexing to pet owners in genuine financial need.

Please inform Council of any change of address, or if you sell or give away your pet, if your pet goes missing for more than 3 days, or if your pet dies.

Lost animals

If your cat or dog goes missing, contact Council and provide a description of the pet, where and when it was last seen and your contact details. You can improve the possibility of your pet's safe return by ensuring your pet's microchip details are up to date and including an alternative contact.

Dog friendly parks

Council provides four dog leash-free parks to enable your dog to run freely off the lead in a fenced area. Leash-free parks are located:

- Brian Martin Oval, Centennial Park, 17 Centennial Rd, Bowral
- Alexandra Square Park, 6 Alice St, Mittagong
- Seymour Park,2-10 Spencer St, Moss Vale

Dogs on leash are permitted in all Council parks and open spaces.

Your dog must be under the effective control of a competent person at all times when out in public. This means that it must be on a leash and under the control of someone capable of restraining it. All dogs apart from genuine assistance dogs are not allowed within 10 metres of a children's play area.

RSPCA Seniors for Seniors Program

RSPCA NSW offers a 50% discount on pets for Seniors Card holders if they adopt a dog or cat over the age of eight years old. This program also comes with access to the Home Ever After program, which is a tailored, future care plan for pets should something happen to their owner.

Preparing for and staying safe during emergencies

Emergencies such as bushfires, floods, storms, loss of utilities and risks to human and animal health can strike at any time in the Wingecarribee - sometimes without warning.


It is important to understand your risks and the types of emergencies which might affect you, your family, or your business, and have an up-to-date plan to ensure you are adequately prepared to take appropriate and safe action when facing an emergency event.

Stay up to date about emergencies by visiting the Hazards Near Me app. The app shows information from emergency services on bushfires, floods, tsunamis and advice on what to do to stay safe. Download the app:

AIDER (Assist Infirm, Disabled and Elderly Residents) program

The AIDER program is a free, one-off service which supports some of our most at-risk community members.

The AIDER program is designed for people who have limited domestic support available from family, relatives, friends or other services. This could include older people, people with disability, and people who are already receiving community assistance and services. Their property must also be on bush fire prone land (land that can support a bush fire or be subject to bush fire attack).

AIDER services can include:

- clearing gutters
- · thinning vegetation around the home
- · removing leaf and tree debris
- · trimming branches from close to the home
- · mowing or slashing long grass.


