
REPLIES TO GENERAL BUSINESS QUESTIONS – COUNCIL MEETING WEDNESDAY, 24 OCTOBER 2018

1. SALE OF FRANKLAND STREET MITTAGONG

Clr I M Scandrett requested the GM and Council staff to provide an update on the forthcoming sale of Frankland Street (the former Mittagong Sewerage Works) and include details of the progress of subdivision for the sale.

REPLY FROM DEPUTY GENERAL MANAGER OPERATIONS, FINANCE AND RISK

Further action to market or sell the Frankland/Roscoe Street site has been suspended awaiting the Section 4.55 review of the Development Consent for the site.

2. COMMUNITY OVAL

Clr I M Scandrett requested the GM detail any discussions Council has had regarding any developments on or including the community oval, and the adjoining Council lands, and education lands.

REPLY FROM GROUP MANAGER PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT AND REGULATORY SERVICES

Council staff are not aware of any discussions concerning the community oval or adjoining / adjacent Council lands or educational lands relating to any development.

3. COMMUNITY CONSULTATION FOR PROPOSED LEASE OF ABORIGINAL CULTURAL CENTRE

Clr L A C Whipper noted that he and Councillor Markwart attended the first community consultation on the Aboriginal Cultural Centre lease. However, Clrs Whipper and Markwart were asked to leave the meeting shortly after it commenced. As a result, Clr Whipper requested clarification on whether Council will be present at the next consultation meeting on 5 November 2018, in the interests of equity and transparency.

REPLY FROM GROUP MANAGER CORPORATE AND COMMUNITY

The consultants engaged to undertake the consultation have advised that based on initial conversations with stakeholders Councillors and Council staff should not attend the consultation workshops, including the workshop scheduled for 5 November 2018.
