### PURPOSE

The purpose of this Mayoral Minute is to a nominate motion for inclusion in the National General Assembly Annual Conference Agenda Paper and this item be forwarded to the Australian Local Government Association by the closing date of Friday 30 March 2018.

### RECOMMENDATION

1. **THAT the National General Assembly support a call for the Australian Local Government Association to advocate for inclusion of issues surrounding exploitation of children, women and animals as consideration in Council's Procurement Policies.**
2. **THAT where goods and services are proven to have a negative social or environmental impact or exploits Indigenous Cultures, children, women or animals or negative social impact due to manufacture or production that these be avoided.**

### REPORT

Due to the ongoing exploitation of cultural, environmental and gender sensitivities exhibited by some corporations, questions should be raised about the moral and social issues employed by Local Government in procuring goods and services.

There is an increasing awareness and social conscience growing globally in relation to the role that Governments play in adopting a role of responsible governance and intergenerational equity.
