Hi Susan and Michael,

Thanks for the discussion today. To confirm, the Department have received several submissions relating to the implied dwelling number for Wingecarribee. The implied dwelling figure for Wingecarribee in the draft Regional Plan 2041 incorrectly included 13,000 new homes, instead of 9,544 by 2041. This error will be updated in the final plan.

I note I have advised that we will put a comment in regarding the population projections being drawn from those released in 2022, and that they are subject to change over time. This will be supported by a link to DPEs website for population projections.
