

# How to access e-Track information relating to the Neighbour Notification or Development Application enquiry

If you have received a Neighbour Notification letter from Council relating to a Development application, there is additional information and publicly available documents that you can access via the [DA tracker](#) page on Councils website with a link through to the e-Track.

Information relating to the proposed development can be viewed on Councils DA Tracker or by contacting Council's Customer Service Centre between 8.30am – 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays).

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Any person during this period of public exhibition may lodge with the Council a submission (either in support or by way of objection) in relation to the proposed development. 
Where a submission is made by way of an objection, the grounds of objection are required to be specified in the submission. Please refer to the Development Application (**DA**) number in lodging a submission and provide your postal address, email address and a contact telephone

## Step 1

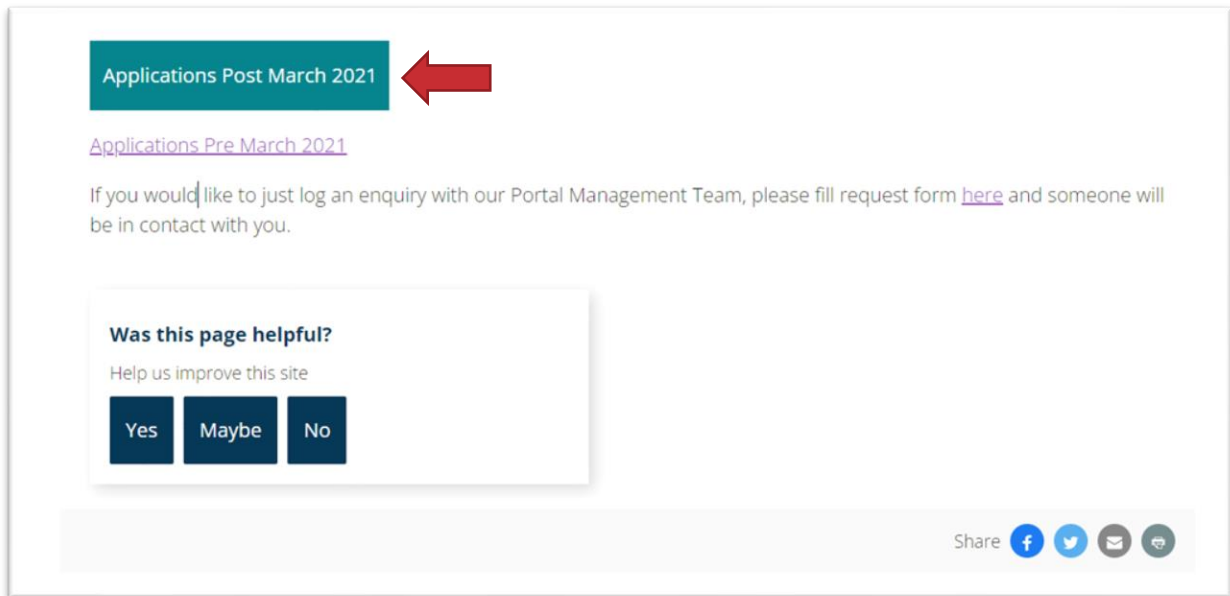
Visit the DA tracker page on Wingecarribee Shire Council website as outlined in the Neighbour Notification letter.

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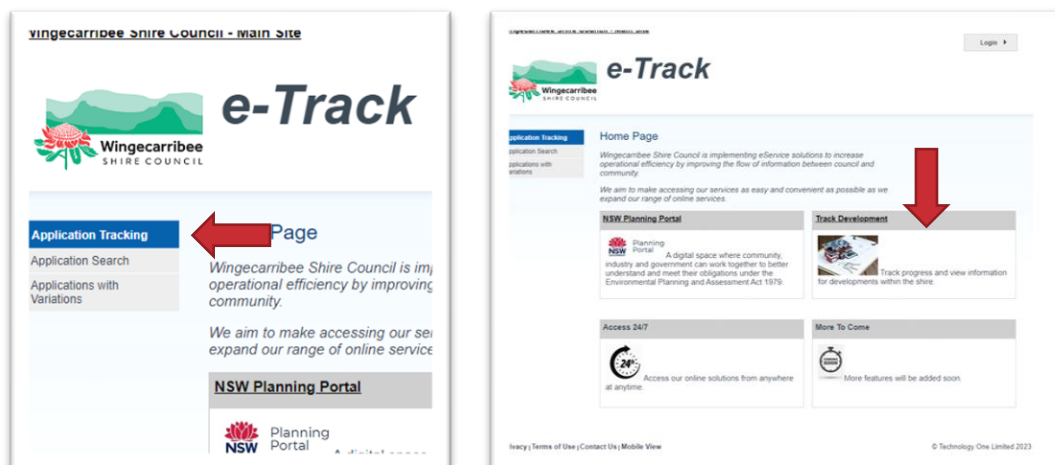
## Step 2

Once you have accessed the DA tracker page scroll down the page and click on the 'Applications Post March 2021' to access the e-Track Development Application information.



## Step 3

Once you've clicked on the link in the previous step, it will open access to [e-Track](#) so you can search for the Development Application you have been notified about in the Neighbour Notification letter or any other Development Application lodged with Council that you would like to find out more about in the Wingecarribee Shire area. *You do not need to Login to access this information.*



You can either select [Application Tracking](#) from the left hand menu or select [Track Development](#). This will open the Application Search page.

## Step 4

Enter the Development Application number, in the Application ID field of the Application Search box. You'll find the Development Application number on your Neighbour Notification letter. Now click the **Search** button.


