### Terms and Conditions

#### 1. Participating in the Eucalyptus photo competition.

A Entries are submitted via Wingecarribee Shire Council email address [mail@wsc.nsw.gov.au](mailto:mail@wsc.nsw.gov.au).

b. Entry is only open to individuals who have participated in photographing Eucalyptus trees in the Southern Highlands between 1-3-25 to 20-3-25. Trees can be photographed on private or public land. Winners will be drawn 23 March 2025.

c. Entrants under 18 years of age must have legal parental or guardian consent to participate in the photographic competition. By submitting an entry, the entrant warrants that they are 18 years or over or otherwise possess legal parental or guardian consent.

d. Individuals can participate as many times as they wish as long as they adhere to 1b. and 1c. However, an individual cannot win more than one prize.

e. Wingecarribee Shire Council (Council) staff will be reviewing submissions. Duplicate submissions (i.e. an individual has submitted the same photos on multiple occasions to increase their chances of winning) will lead to entries being considered void. Before making a decision, Council will consider 1f.

f. If a mistake is made when completing an entry, individuals can easily rectify them before submitting, or by sending an email to [mail@wsc.nsw.gov.au](mailto:mail@wsc.nsw.gov.au).

g. Council may consider applications to be void an entry if an individual has not followed 1b. and 1c.

#### 2. Responsibility of participants

a. Individuals visiting bushland reserves and/or National Parks are responsible for their own safety.

b. Participants understand and accept that, by participating, they are subject to the usual risks that are associated with bushwalking.

c. If you share an image on a social media page (e.g. Twitter or Instagram) or website, you are subject to their Terms and Conditions and Privacy Statement.

#### 3. Prizes

a. Competition winners will be selected by independent person.

b. If the individual isn't able to accept their prize at the earth hour event then an alternative will be sort.

### Privacy

By submitting a photograph to the email address above, you will be providing Wingecarribee Shire Council (Council) with personal information such as your name, contact details (i.e. your email address) and postcode. This information may be personal information for the purposes of the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* (PPIPA).

This information is being collected for the purpose of allowing you to participate in the photography competition and if selected for a prize for it to be awarded. Your email address will be used to confirm your entry and to share further information about relevant environmental programs in the Southern Highlands. In addition, if you elect to receive more information about environmental programs that are running in the Southern Highlands, you will be added to Council's [Wingecarribee Web](#) and [Southern Highlands Nature News](#) newsletter's subscriber list.

The intended recipients of your personal information are:

In addition, your personal information may be accessed by persons who have been granted lawful access under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*.

Supply of the information is voluntary (i.e. not required by law), however if you cannot or do not provide the requested information, you will be unable to enter the draw to win one of the listed prizes.

You have a right to access or correct your personal information at any time. Council will deal with any such request in accordance with the PPIPA.
