What goes in your bin?

General Mixed Waste Bin

Yes	No
Food scraps	Timber
Paper contamination with food e.g. pizza boxes	Bricks
Bagged ash and vacuum dust	Plasterboard
Styrofoam packaging and food containers	Hazardous waste e.g. oil, fuel, asbestos, batteries *
Food packaging e.g. plastic bags, plastic wraps and meat trays	Green waste
	Rocks and soil

*Hazardous Waste can be disposed of through the Resource Recovery Centre. Fees may apply

Mixed Recycling Bin

Yes	No
Paper, newspaper, cardboard	Styrofoam/polystyrene
Plastic containers and bottles	Coffee cups
Steel and aluminum cans	Soft plastics e.g. plastic bags, plastic wrapping, plastic sheeting
Milk and juice cartons	Hazardous waste e.g. oil, fuel, asbestos, light globes, batteries
Empty aerosol cans with nozzles removed	Any item smaller than a credit card e.g. bread tags, pegs, bottle caps
Clean, empty paint cans	Paper contamination with food e.g. pizza boxes
Glass bottles and jars	Broken bottles or jars
	Serviettes, paper plates and tissues
	Ceramics, crockery, china or pyrex
	Mirrors of windows
