PURPOSE

CIrs I M Scandrett and L A C Whipper abstained from voting.

The <u>Acting General Manager</u> advised that Clr P W Nelson with the lowest number of votes would be excluded from the next round of voting.

Following this round of voting, the <u>Acting General Manager</u> advised that the following votes had been received:

Clr G J Andrews: 4 votesClr G M Turland: 2 votes

CIrs I M Scandrett and L A C Whipper abstained from voting.

The Acting General Manager declared Clr G J Andrews elected as Deputy Mayor.

The Acting General Manager vacated the Chair for the Mayor Clr T D Gair.

The <u>Mayor Clr T D Gair</u> thanked those who voted for him and stated that he hoped to work with Councillors in a conducive and productive manner for the next twelve months. The Mayor expressed his support for and thanks to Council staff and advised that he looks forward to working with them. The Mayor congratulated Clr Andrews on his appointment as Deputy Mayor and advised he looks forward to working with him.

<u>The Deputy Mayor Clr G J Andrews</u> congratulated the Mayor Clr T D Gair on his appointment and expressed that he was humbled by his election and mindful of the importance of the Deputy Mayor's role and the commitment of Councillors to the community. The Deputy Mayor thanked the Councillors for their support.

The Mayor Clr T D Gair offered his commiserations to Clrs G M Turland, P W Nelson and G McLaughlin and thanked them for running for election.

<u>CIr G McLaughlin</u> congratulated the <u>Mayor CIr T D Gair</u> and <u>Deputy Mayor CIr G J Andrews</u> on their respective appointments and expressed that he looks forward to working with them.
